BSG Spring Meeting: Norwich

The Spring Meeting of the British Society of Gastroenterology was held at the University of East Anglia, Norwich on 24-26 March, under the Presidency of Professor C G Clark. The first day of the meeting was an International Teaching Day on 'Extremes of nutrition'; on the following two days, 110 papers and eight poster communications were presented to the Society. A lecture 'Secretion: perspective on pumps and pathways' was given by the 1982 BSG Research Medallist, Professor R Maynard Case, and the Hopkins Endoscopy Prize was presented to Dr H J O'Connor. The meeting included a joint Pathology/Radiology Symposium, and an Endoscopic Symposium on 'Documentation in endoscopy'. The Sainsbury Centre for the Visual Arts was made available to the Society for the Conference Dinner, and a conducted tour of the collection of modern art in the Centre was the main event in the social programme for members and guests.

Wellcome Museum of the History of Medicine

The Wellcome Museum of the History of Medicine is a department of the Science Museum, and is largely based in the collections made by Sir Henry Wellcome FRS (1853-1936), which were tranferred by the Wellcome Trustees on long-term loan to the Science Museum in 1977. The Wellcome Trust has made available to the Science Museum £650 000 towards cataloguing and conservation expenses, and the musuem is devoting two galleries (some 1400m² in all) to the display of items from the Wellcome Collection. The first of these galleries, Glimpses of Medical History, opened to the public in December 1980. The major new gallery, The Science and Art of Medicine, with its 537 display units, has recently been opened and provides a detailed story of developments in all branches of medicine in a variety of cultures, with specific reference to the scientific basis of medicine. This new gallery is intended for a wide range of visitors from senior school children to members of the medical profession.
