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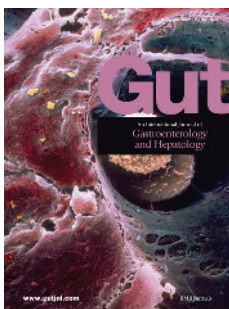
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False-colour SEM of leucocytes within the liver. Professors PM Motta and T Fujita/Science Photo Library.
